The KS4 team will be working hard on Thursday 12 and Friday 13 August to give you the help and support you need. Please note, subject teachers will **not** be available during the school holidays.

Any student who is disappointed by the grade or grades awarded this summer can target a higher grade by taking the GCSE in that subject(s) in November 2021. Please note that the deadline for entries is 1 October.

Due to the robust and heavily regulated grade awarding process for 2021, it is highly unlikely that the grade or grades awarded this summer will be incorrect and the Government expects that there will be relatively few appeals. However, students who consider that an error has been made in determining their grade do have the right to appeal. **The appeal must come from the student, not a parent, and students should be aware that if they appeal their grade could go down. Any change in the grade will be final and irreversible, even if the grade goes down.** Details of how to appeal can be found on the school website.
