



HANLEY CASTLE HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS



What to wear

- ✓ **White collared shirt**, tucked in with the top button done up
- ✓ **College Tie**, worn 7 stripes long, up to the collar
- ✓ **Hanley Castle blazer** to be worn at all times
- ✓ **Black tailored trousers**
- ✓ **Tailored shorts**
- ✓ **Hanley Castle skirt** (pleated or straight – minimum 18 inches or 45cm) with pelican on waistband, worn to full length
- ✓ **Black tights or black socks**
- ✓ **Black school shoes** (traditional style, no trainers)
- ✓ **Hanley Castle V-neck jumper or black knitted V-neck jumper with no logos or labels** (optional – not to replace blazer)
- ✓ One pair of **stud earrings** and a **watch**
- ✓ **Hair – traditional style** and colour with no patterns or bright colours. Non-religious head coverings are not permitted.
- ✓ **Coats** – worn in poor weather; removed for lessons (not to replace blazer)

What not to wear

- ✗ **Footwear** - canvas shoes, trainers, boots
- ✗ **Trousers** – skinny fit, elastic/legging/lycra based, Cropped
- ✗ **Jewellery** – Bracelets, necklaces, rings
- ✗ **Piercings** – multiple piercings, hooped earrings, hanging earrings, facial piercings
- ✗ **Socks** – white or coloured socks
- ✗ **Hoodies**
- ✗ **Make up/Nails** – heavy makeup, nail varnish/acrylic nails/gel nail extensions, false eyelashes



NEXT STEPS

- Students wearing an incorrect item of uniform will be provided with replacement uniform to be returned at the end of the day (a personal item will be exchanged and securely stored e.g. mobile phone, bus pass).
- Jewellery and clothing items not in line with the school's uniform expectations will be confiscated and available for collection at the end of each week.
- Students wearing excessive make-up or jewellery will be given the opportunity to resolve this before sanctions are applied in line with the behaviour management policy
