Preparing for the exams

Preparation began on 8 September.

- Homework is set on Tuesdays and is due the following Tuesday.
- Six homework tasks are each half a practice exam paper. In other weeks, students are directed to use Sparx Maths Independent Learning, on topics informed by teacher feedback.
- Three class practice tests (Mini-mocks) use exam papers cut down to fit a full one-hour lesson.

Planned class tests: 29 September, 20 October and 17 November.

Teachers mark both the half practice exam papers and Mini-mocks.

How to revise

- Use notes, RSG Crossover and Higher books or topic videos to help with practice homework.
- When marked homework or tests are returned, students choose three topics to improve. These are their Target Topic Trios.
- After going through the work in class, practise these topics in the Independent Learning section of Sparx Maths.

Knowledge to be assessed	Revision resources
Most exam topics have been taught. Some have not yet been studied. The six topic areas include: 1) Number: fractions, percentages and standard form. 2) Algebra: equations, expressions and graphs. 3) Ratio, proportion and rates of change: sharing, scaling and speed. 4) Geometry and measures: angles, area, Pythagoras and trigonometry. 5) Probability: chance and tree diagrams. 6) Statistics: averages, tables and graphs.
