

## **Catch Up Intervention 2015-2016**

Entry and Exit tests indicate that **all** students made progress of during the Y7 Catch-Up intervention, 10 % being the minimum amount of progress made.

The students who received both Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up intervention made the following progress in their English and Maths lessons:

### **English**

23% of students made a '**significant**' level of progress

46% of students made achieved their '**expected**' level of progress

31% of students made '**some**' level of progress in Literacy

There were no students who made '**little**' or '**no**' progress

### **Maths**

8% of students made a '**significant**' level of progress in Maths

31% of students made achieved their '**expected**' levels of progress in Maths

38% of students made '**some**' level of progress in Maths

23% of students made '**little**' progress in Numeracy

There were no students who made '**no**' progress

Of those who completed single Literacy Catch-Up Intervention:

50% of students made a '**significant**' level of progress

50% of students made a '**some**' level of progress

Of those who completed single Numeracy Catch-Up Intervention:

75% of students made achieved their '**expected**' level of progress in Numeracy

25% of students made '**some**' level of progress in Numeracy
